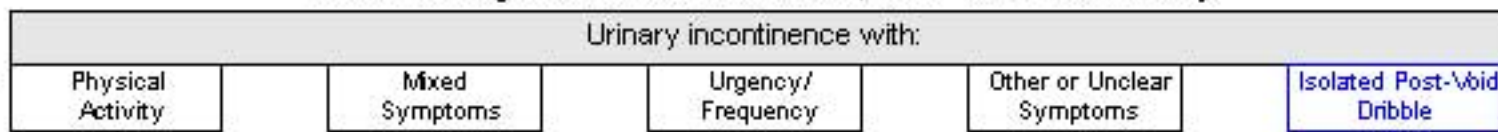

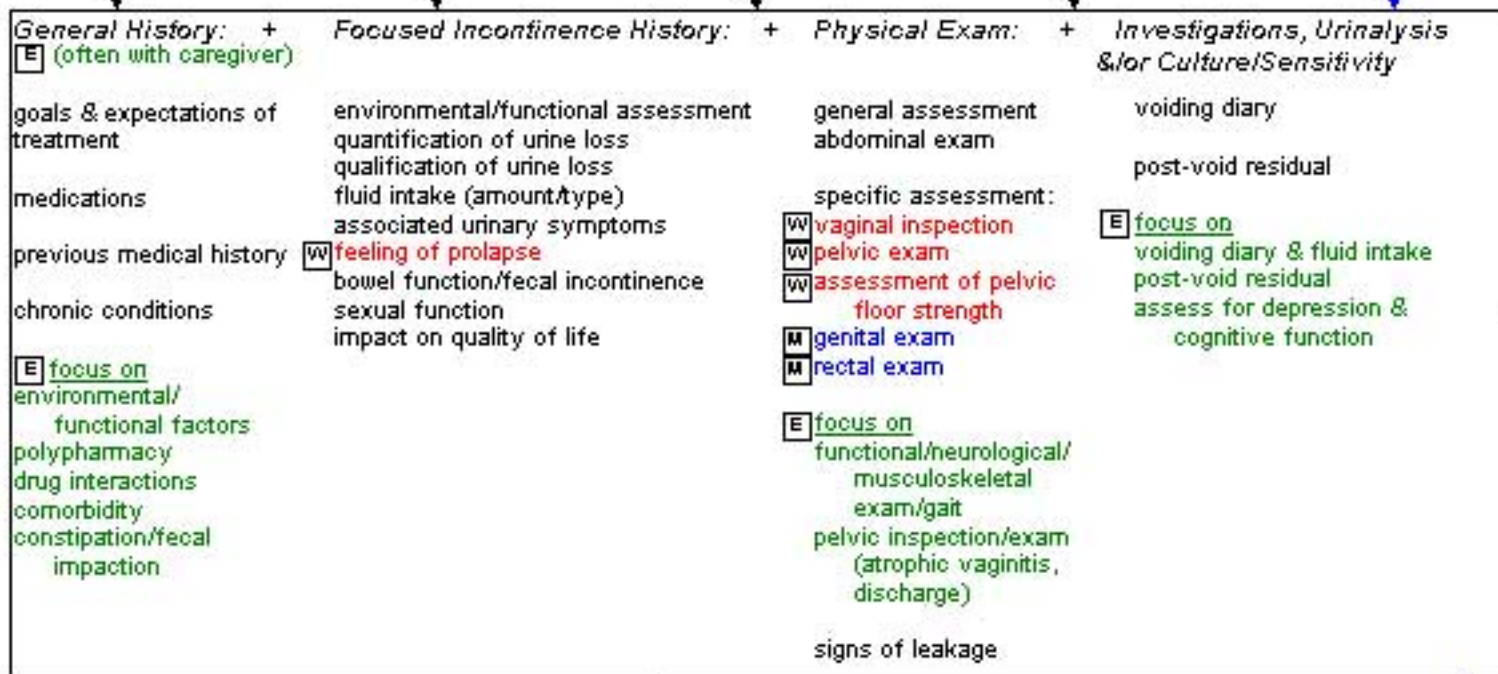

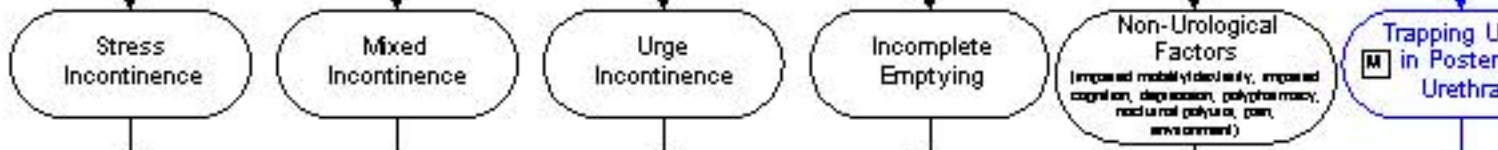


Initial History/ Clinical Assessment

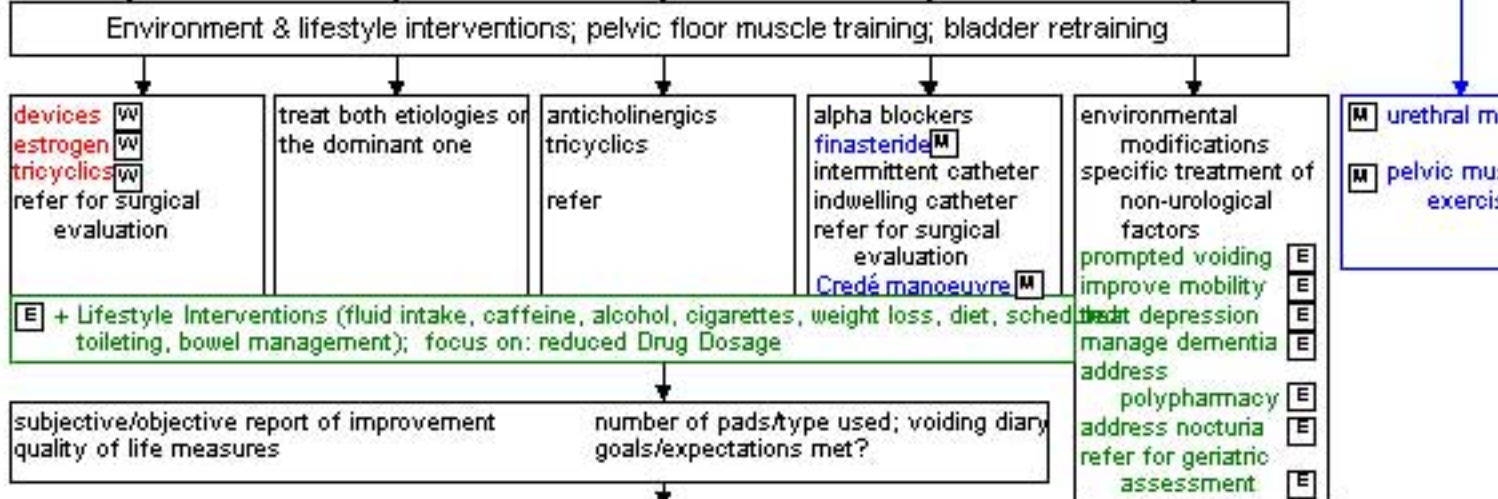


Complex History:
 significant pelviorgan prolapse [W]
 possible obstruction [M]
 hematuria
 pelvic pain
 significant post-void residual
 recurrent UTI
 pelvic irradiation
 neurologic condition
 radical pelvic surgery
 suspected fistula
 fecal incontinence
 complex psychiatric causes
 complex comorbidities [E]

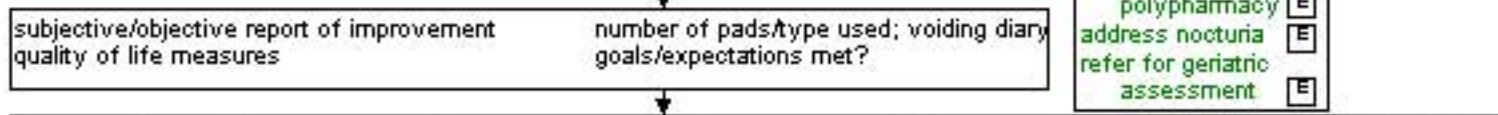
Presumed Etiology
